The THC level in marijuana of the 1970's was just 3% and has been increasing over the decades. From 2010 up to today, THC levels have increased up to 50-90% depending on the form in which it is being used.

Δ Delta 8 THC
or
Δ Delta 9 THC...
What's the difference?

Delta 8 is known as "Weed Light". It is THC extracted from the Hemp Plant. Retailers market it with their CBD products making it even easier for teens to get their hands on because the legal age to purchase CBD in New York State is 18! There is THC in this product! Beware and keep away from youth!

FYI: Delta 9 THC is the more potent cannabinoid that produces the strong psychoactive effect as in the items shown to the right.

You are probably familiar with the meaning behind 420...but have you heard about 710?

710 rotated and flipped spells OIL. OIL stands for hash oil, shatter, wax. Cannabis users may have items such as clothing, stickers, etc. with 710 printed on them. Parents beware: it is also a day celebrated for use: 7/10 at 7:10.

710
