- REVIEW OF AGENDA AND PREVIOUS MINUTES
- April minutes approved by Liz Threehouse
- MEMBER NEWS AND UPDATES
- Liz asked if anyone had heard about the possibility of New York allowing online sales of marijuana. Katelynn said she would check with the Office of Cannabis Management.


## Coalition Member Discussion:

- Stephanie and Katelynn asked about what members feel is working and not working in the coalition. The topic of community events come up. Liz stated she would like to get back involved into community events, especially sporting events. Liz would like to get involved in youth/kids' events as well.
- Mike said to continue to go to sporting events/tabling events and to have the giveaways. They are popular with the kids.
- Stephanie asked about having a quarterly in-person meeting. The group agreed that this would be something they are interested in doing.
- Carrie brought up having more youth involvement in the coalition. Carrie also discussed the development of self- advocacy. The topic of youth groups came up. Liz said the Olean Public Library has a youth group. Sydney said they have a teen night once a week at the library that there is a Youth Action Committee there as well. Mike said that during the school year National Honor Society members need volunteer hours and sometimes struggle to find places to volunteer. Katie spoke about the teen group at the new Recovery Center. It has been on Wednesday but is changing to a different night because Epic Church holds a teen night on Wednesday that is well attended. Al said he is available to give presentations for human trafficking prevention to teen groups.
- Katie suggested doing an agency "spotlight" on one or two agencies at each meeting instead of the round robin group update. This would give one or two people the chance to talk a little longer about what it is they are doing and give members the opportunity to ask them questions. The development of a spotlight/interest sign in sheet was discussed. Next month, HCC Coordinators will share a one pager in generating questions prior to the next HCC meeting.
- Al described barriers regarding meeting time. Al recommended setting aside meeting times (set times) for more coalition members to attend.
- Sydney said that with many coalitions the coordinators are the ones doing most of the work and reporting out about it. She suggested an MOU for member agencies to agree to participate a certain amount to be a member of the coalition. Both Carrie and Erica stated that Agency MOU's will reach out to different people and the coalition will be more sustainable.


## COMMITTEE DISCUSSION

- Katelynn asked if everyone knew the five subcommittees that are a part of HCC. She explained that there is Media and Marketing, Data and Assessment, Executive, Strategic Planning and Cannabis Advisory.
- Al said he would be more likely to attend meetings if they stayed on the same day/time each month. Consistency is important.
- Al would like to sit on the Marketing Committee. Will give feedback to coordinators regarding Data \& Assessment Committee.
- Mike would like to still be on Executive and CAD Committee
- Liz still wants to be on Marketing Committee
- Katie Connors would still like to be on the CAD committee.
- Suggestions regarding new members to committee meetings were discussed. Katelynn will email when next meetings are to all coalition members.
