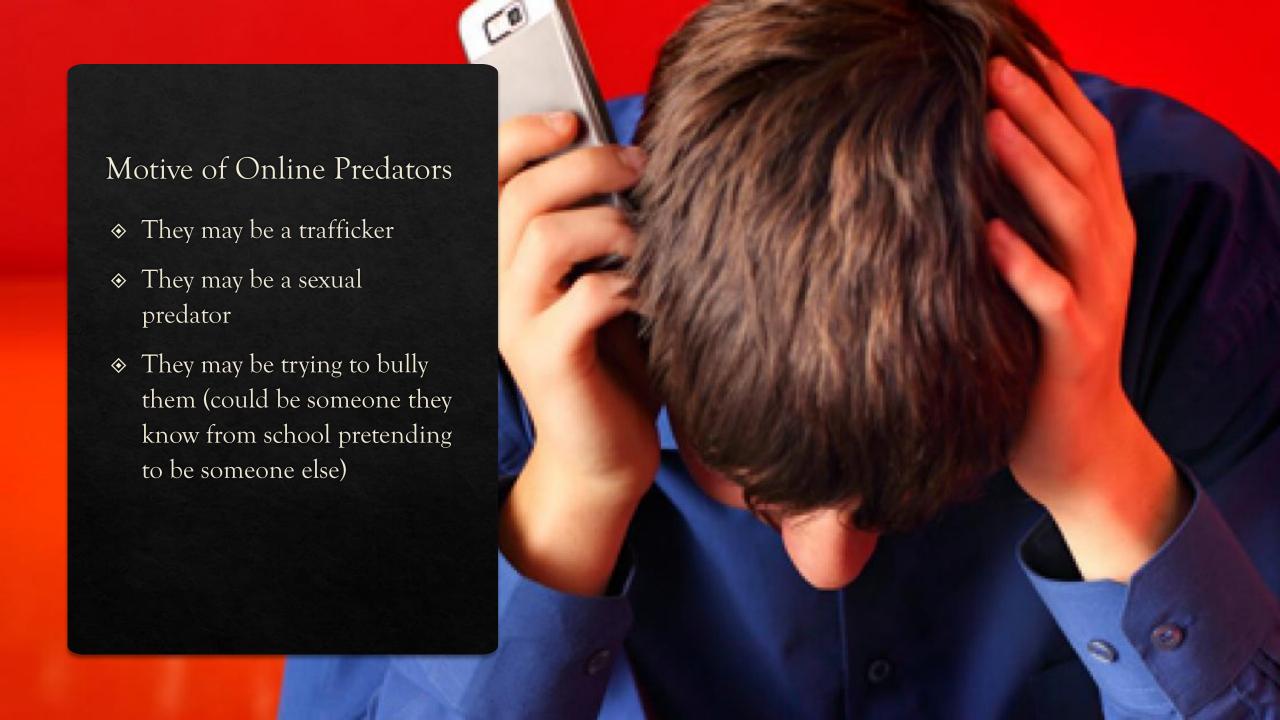




What Online Predators Do...

- * Target vulnerable youth by manipulating them (any child is vulnerable, but they will look for those that show signs on social media of problems at home, with friends, self-esteem issues, etc.)
- Pretend to be their friend and offer advice
- ♦ Turn the child against their parents
- ♦ Groom and seduce them
- Manipulate the child into doing things such as taking risky photos
- Once the predator has those photos, they can use them to blackmail the child to get them to do what they want
- ♦ Get the child to provide other personal information or lure them from their home



What Can Parents Do to Protect Their Children?

- Help them to feel comfortable to talk with you when they have a problem
- ♦ Limit their screen time
- Monitor what they do on the Internet
- ♦ Know their passwords to their social media accounts
- Utilize parental controls

Establish Internet Safety Rules:

- Never give out personal information such as where you live
- ♦ Never go to someone that they met online
- Don't send photos of themselves
- ♦ Don't use private chat rooms

What Are Decoy Apps?



- Apps that are available for both iPhones and Androids
- ♦ They require a password to gain access to the app once it is installed
- ♦ On the surface they look like something else (for example a calculator)
- Very problematic for parents because teens can keep dangerous content from parents such as photos and messages

Popular Decoy Apps

- Photo Album Vault: Appears as a screen lock but directly captures pics and stores on the Cloud
- <u>Secret Calculator App</u>: Hides photos and videos behind a calculator
- <u>KeepSafe Photo Vault</u>: Fingerprint ID to unlock; stored photos are encrypted
- Vault: Looks like a camera but when unauthorized users accesses it, will take a photo of them (hides call logs, personal photos, contact lists)
- Gallery Vault: Can create a fake pin and content to fool people, shaking phone will close the app
- Double App: Not only hides messages, videos, and photos but it can also hide other apps within it











Install a Parental Controls App

With a Parental Controls App you can do the following:

- Monitor for bullying and predators
- Manage screentime and create schedules
- Filter websites and block certain sites or categories
- Receive location alerts when your child leaves a certain place
